# I trained an AI to do my virtual team's **Monday** — in **one day**.

That's when everything changed. **4 kids under 5. 4 businesses. 8 named AI agents.** No virtual team. No manager hires. No 11pm Slack threads. Here's the story — and the roster.

## WHERE THIS STARTED

# I HAD A VIRTUAL TEAM. IT WAS WORKING. SORT OF.

Four businesses. A handful of contractors. Social handled offshore. Admin run by a VA. Design by a freelancer. On paper — fine. In practice — **I was managing the managers.**

The slack lag. The "can you clarify" replies at 11pm my time. The drift — the thing you asked for and the thing you got. The retraining every time someone left. The cost of keeping people fed when revenue dipped. The meetings about meetings.

And the kids. **Four under five.** Nova running on the same fumes. The week stopped being mine somewhere around the second one.

Then I trained an agent to do a **specific** job. One that my VA was spending most of a Monday on. Not a generic GPT. A named, prompted, instructed character — with a job description, a tone, and a single trigger.

It did the Monday's worth of work. **In one day.**

Then it kept doing it. **Day after day.** No retraining. No bad-day variability. No frustration with human behaviour. It just **worked.**

What changed for me wasn't time on a calendar. It was **headspace.** The wall between "I have an idea" and "the work is shipped" — gone.

**Whatever I could think, I could do.**

If one agent can give you that — what could eight do?

THE FIRST THREE

# THREE ROLES. THREE AGENTS. SAME WEEK.

Social media. Admin. Design. The first three jobs my virtual team was running — replaced one at a time, the same week, and they've been running ever since.

<p><b>MIRIAM</b></p> <p><b>SOCIAL &amp; CONTENT</b></p> <p>Drafts, schedules, replies. Knows my voice cold.</p>	<p><b>BEFORE</b> VA posting 2–3x a week. Captions in their voice, not mine. Two days lag on every reply. Inconsistent.</p> <p><b>AFTER</b> Posts <b>daily</b>, in voice, scheduled a week ahead. Replies queued for me. <b>Never misses.</b></p>
<p><b>JARVESI</b></p> <p><b>CHIEF OF STAFF</b></p> <p>Reads my inbox + Telegram + calendar. Queues my day.</p>	<p><b>BEFORE</b> VA copy-pasting summaries 1–2x a day. I'd still re-read everything because I didn't trust it.</p> <p><b>AFTER</b> Live triage. Tells me what to look at next, in priority order. <b>I don't open my inbox first thing anymore.</b></p>
<p><b>NOAH</b></p> <p><b>DESIGN &amp; CREATIVE</b></p> <p>Mockups, briefs, ad concepts. Visual quality bar.</p>	<p><b>BEFORE</b> "Quick design tweak" → 2-day turnaround. 9pm "can you check this" emails. Endless rounds.</p> <p><b>AFTER</b> Mockup in minutes. <b>10 variations</b> when I want them. No "is this what you meant" — it knows.</p>

# FROM THREE TO EIGHT.

Once those first three were running, the pattern was obvious. Same approach for sales. Then finance. Then ops. Each one named. Each one trained. Each one kept doing the job. Twenty-four-seven. Without frustration.

• **JARVESI**

**CHIEF OF STAFF**

Reads everything. Queues my day. The agent that decides what I touch next.

• **SOLOMON**

**SALES & REVENUE**

Pipeline + proposals + follow-ups. The agent that closes deals while I'm at school pickup.

• **ENOCH**

**FINANCE & ACCOUNTING**

Quotes, invoices, GST, reconciliation. Knows Xero, Stripe, the bank.

• **EZRA**

**SIDELINE OPS**

Order intake → supplier POs → mockups → dispatch. Sideline's hands.

• **PAUL**

**RTS FUNDING**

Grant criteria, application drafts, deadline tracking. Reads the boring docs.

• **NOAH**

**DESIGN & CREATIVE**

Mockups, image briefs, ad concepts. The taste filter.

• **MIRIAM**

**SOCIAL & CONTENT**

Drafts, schedules, replies. Voice on lock.

• **SARAH**

**RESEARCH & IMPROVEMENT**

Watches the others. Surfaces what's leaking. Makes the team better.
